Program

The *Head of School's Scholarship - Striving Scholar Award* provides outstanding 6th-grade students the opportunity to attend St. Andrew's recognizing their significant potential as merit scholars. The Scholarship Committee selects a recipient on the basis of the student's application materials including the students' previous year's academic performance and teacher recommendations.

The program is open to all current St. Andrew's 5th-grade students who intend to re-enroll for the 2020-2021 school year.

Award

The family of the Striving Scholar will be awarded \$2400 for the 2020-2021 school year.

Application Process

Application for a Head of School's Scholarship is completed when you:

- Collect and submit Teacher Recommendation Forms (2)
- Submit a Head of School's Scholarship Application Form
- Schedule a student interview.

Scholarship materials are due March 13. Interviews will take place the week of March 23. Scholarship recipients will be notified by April 3.
