Perhaps more than ever, I hope this finds you in great health and spirits! We have been busy over the past week preparing for our transition to the remote learning plan that will begin on Wednesday, March 25. There have been a couple of important details that emerged recently that we wanted to make sure everyone knew. That's the purpose of this update. Please note the following.

- The plan for the pick-up of materials has shifted a bit. Due to the Governor's Executive Order limiting gatherings of more than 10 people, we will not have families come to the cafeteria to pick up their children's needed materials. Rather, we will use the pick-up lanes on both sides of the school. Please note the following schedule arranged by families' last names. ***When picking up your kiddos' materials, if they are in Orchestra with Mrs. Bradford, please ask for their instrument as well.***
